How many guests can I have for the hostess price?

It depends on your "tribe." In times of COVID, you will decide what kind of social distancing you are comfortable with. We suggest that five attendees is a good number. You will receive five swag bags in the cost of the hostess package. See the Information page to find out more about swag bags.

What are the requirements to be a virtual hostess?

You must have a good internet service that will support the use of devices by your friends. You need a distraction-free environment; possibly extra rooms, and the ability to pull together the friends and food required.

What if my house won't work as a venue for the event?

If you want to hostess the Living Your Dreams Conference,, you have a few options: Ask a friend to hostess if you pay for the hostess package; find a hotel room or suite; or find another free venue like a church fellowship hall, community building, or even a campsite or camper (if you live in the South!) Feel free to be creative.

Do I have to cook?

No, feel free to order takeout, buy sushi or other premade food at the grocery store, or organize a potluck. All you have to do is plan.

What kind of support will I get as a hostess?

Hostesses receive a link where they can sign up for a planning session with conference staff, as well as response to emails sent to lilivingyourdreamsconferenceWV. They receive the number to a cell phone they can text any time before or during the conference, and a Virtual Hostess Planning Packet. We may not be able to solve every problem that comes up, so that's where you will step up as a savvy hostess--for example, we do have pre-recorded sessions accessible only to you, so if you can't view the live Zoom, you can pivot.

You will have a phone number to text or call us before or during the conference.

You and your guests will need to choose your sessions ahead of time by going to livingyourdreams.org and reading the session information. Then you will complete the Google Form you will receive in a hostess email from The Living Your Dreams Conference. You will need to forward the link to your attendees.

During the conference, you will have your schedule posted somewhere for all attendees to access. This could be a paper copy or an email you send them. We will be glad to help you double check your schedule before the conference; hostesses get a link to a calendar for scheduling a planning session.

You will receive a special discount on a 4-pack of wine for the wine tasting if you order it online from West Virginia Fruit and Berry at wvfruitandberry.com You can also buy WV Fruit and Berry wines at local grocery stores and Sam's Club. You will need to provide 4 desserts to go with this wine. The chef at Alpine Lake Resort suggests cheesecake bites (Many stores sell them in the frozen food section, or you can make desserts to pair. If you have guests avoiding sugar, you could choose four cheeses to pair with the wines. You can google pairing suggestions for cherry, blackberry, elderberry, and raspberry dessert wines.

The swag bags are free for up to five guests. If you would like additional swag bags, you will need to purchase them at \$4.99 each S&H..
